At Alert Level 2, parents and visitors should only enter the site if they absolutely need to. We are required to get everyone who does come onsite to fill out the contact tracing register in the foyer. **Even if you scan the QR code, you must still sign in the contact tracing book.**

We want to acknowledge how thrilled we were with the school play 'Alice in Wonderland'. The students rose to the occasion and we are very proud of each and every one of them. We are also grateful that we got it in before the lockdown began and can now look forward to the school events of the next four weeks.

The lockdown has unfortunately meant that we have had to cancel the school Cross Country at Paradise this year. We have also heard today that the Central Otago Cross Country has been cancelled for 2021.

The Teacher Only Day on Friday 24 September is still going ahead. Staff are attending pre planned professional development in Queenstown on this day and won't be onsite.
